- Operational in various guises:
 - 1994 – Disposal Sales Agency (Defence Export Services)
 - 2000 – Disposal **Services** Agency (Defence Export Services)
 - 2004 – Disposal Services Agency (Defence Logistics Organisation)
 - 2007 – Disposal Services **Authority** (Defence Equipment & Support)
April '07 (DLO + Defence Procurement Agency = DE&S)
- Remit initially MoD only
- Subsequently MoD and Other Government Departments (OGDs)
- Now Public & Private Sector

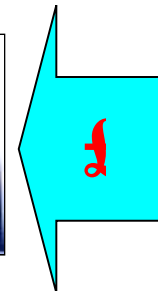
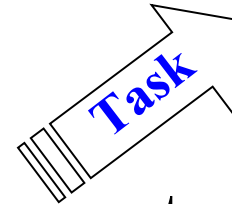

Disposal Solutions2: Why Use the DSA?

Establish a Contract for WEEE

- EU Procurement
- 6-9 months
- Approx 77 man-days expended (c.£25k)
- Manage the contract (c.12 man-days pa)
- Audit the contractor (c. 4 man-days pa)
- Manage the Risk

Disposal Solutions2: Why Use the DSA?

Separate Contractor to handle textiles

Separate Contractor to handle furniture

Separate Contractor to handle specialist waste

Typical Requirement is 5-7 Contractors

- Costing c.£125k to procure
- Costing c.£25k pa to manage
